South Australia

Yalumba 'Y Series' Unwooded Chardonnay, South Australia **\$70.00**

Italy

Crozes-Hermitage AOC, Maison E. Guigal **\$82.00**

An exceptional top wine. A complex bouquet of black olives, licorice, flowers and red and black currants soars from the glass of this Syrah that is aged in 3-year-old barrels as well as larger foudres. Remarkable density, delicious and full-bodied.

Italy

Chianti Reserva DOCG, Marchesi Antinori, Toscana **\$89.00**

Spicy hints of cinnamon and cloves, alongside oaky and piquant peppery rounded flavors. The creamy, sweet and well-balanced palate is followed by an aftertaste of incense, balsamic notes and cherry.

Ricasoli Chianti DOCG Chianti **\$36.00**

Bright ruby red color. Pleasant nose of red fruit with balsamic hints. The entry is fresh, soft and round. Harmonious finish with a pleasant good persistence to the end.

Argentina

Alamos Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina **\$50.00**

"This wine offers immediately appealing dark cherry and chocolate aromas. The palate is saturated with cherries, plums, and chocolate notes, with soft tannins, offering full-bodied pleasure."

Grand Barossa Shiraz, Château Tanunda **\$69.00**

Rioja Reserva DOCa, Bodegas Muga

Outstanding complex wine with great balance. Leather, chocolate-covered dark cherry, rhubarb make a wonderful palette. Oak aged characters; fresh vanilla, coconut and elegant hints of lightly smoked and toasted wood.



Red Wine

South Africa

The Chocolate Block, Boekenhoutskloof **\$95.00**

This legendary blend shows massive floral perfume with underlying redcurrant, cedar, black pepper, coriander spice and hints of Turkish Delight. The macerated red fruit carries through onto a palate layered with marzipan, minerals and a superb velvety structure. Textured, composed and stylish.

New Zealand

Stoneburn Pinot Noir, Marlborough, New Zealand **\$50.00**

" This Pinot Noir has strawberry and black cherry fruit aromas emerging from the glass. The palate combines the flavours of black cherry, spice and subtle French oak to produce a soft, medium bodied wine"

USA

Château Souverain Bourbon Barrel Aged Cabernet Sauvignon, California, USA **\$66.00**

" Aged 60 days in Bourbon Barrels to add layers of maple and caramel. This Cabernet boasts vivid aromas of roasted vanilla, mocha and baking spices with elegant blackberry and ripe cherry flavors. Balanced fruit "
